

RULES AND REGULATION FOR THE NATURE RESERVES

- If you visit the nature reserves, you must follow some simple but fundamental rules.
- Protected territories are a human treasure and, like monuments or any other masterpieces, they must be respected for the next generation
- It is important that if taking part in at the rally d'Italia Sardegna 2008, spectators who wish to stay in such an area, should respect and do everything they can in order to observe the following essential rules:
 - 1) Your behaviour must always be respectful of the ecosystem around you. Please do not leave any kind of waste, do not pick flowers, fruits branches, or take rocks or any other natural element present at your arrival in the area.
 - 2) Do not light any fires, even using proper structures like barbecue.
 - 3) Respect wild animals: you sure observe theme without disturbing their natural habitat and without trying to capture them.
 - 4) Please make sure your children behave in an orderly manner, and are not left unaccompanied because it could be very dangerous.
 - 5) Please inform immediately who is in charge of controlling the area where you are, in case of any dangerous situations (Marshal, Corps of forest rangers, Responsible on field).
 - 6) Smoking is strictly forbidden in the nature reserves.
 - 7) Please park vehicles as not to damage the vegetation around and to keep the vehicles on the roads or areas designated.
 - 8) Near to the forestry barracks keep speed levels down because there areas reserved for animals.
